PENALTIES: (Effective April 16th)

For non-payment of all or any part of the correct, License Fee, the License Inspector or his designated agent, shall levy and collect a late penalty fee of ten (10%) percent during the month of May, fifteen (15%) percent during the month of June and thereafter. If any License Fee shall remain unpaid after May 31st, the License Inspector shall issue an Execution, which shall constitute a lien upon the property of the license for the tax, penalties and costs of collection, and shall proceed in the same manner as prescribed by law for the collection of other taxes.
