## WORK SESSION - RULES OF PROCEDURE

Mayor Crapps stated the Work Session is being held to finish the Rules of Procedure and set them in place for adoption. At this time Mayor Crapps turned the meeting over to Town Manager Luckadoo, who in turn gave the floor to Attorney Spradley.

Attorney Spradley stated the documents you have are the documents that were agreed upon at the last meeting and the only change that has been made since that time is I had Ted add Sections 1-3-21, 1-3-22, 1-3-23 and 1-3-24. The reason for having Ted add those is they are already in our ordinances and when the ordinance was being written, that may or may not be voted on tonight, I found it was going to be easier for Council to repeal the entire article number and put in a new article number instead of trying to say 1-3-1 is changed to this, we are just changing the entire article. Those four things are already in your ordinances, we are just inserting them in here so you will be adopting the whole article at one time instead of by pieces.

The work shop began with Section 1-3-11 Code on Conduct through Section 1-3-24 Repeal, suspension, or alteration of rules. Each Section was read by Manager


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Luckadoo and discussion was held on each section if necessary and advice was sought from Attorney Spradley.



**NEW BUSINESS**


