- In 1993, the Towns of Batesburg and Leesville consolidated to one Town.
- Batesburg-Leesville is located in Lexington and Saluda Counties.
- The Town of Batesburg-Leesville is home to two of South Carolina's Best BBQ Trail Restaurants- Shealy's BBQ and Jackie Hite's Bar-B-Q.

Residents of Batesburg-Leesville

- Batesburg-Leesville is a Town of approximately 5,362 residents and is located two hours from both the beach and the mountains.

Batesburg-Leesville Town Government

- The Batesburg-Leesville Town Council meets the 2nd Monday of each month at 7:00pm in the Town council chambers.
- Mayor Rita Crapps was elected in November of 2013.
- The Town of Batesburg-Leesville operates under the Council-Manager form of government and has approximately 104 employees including part-time and volunteer staff.
- There are eight distinct Council Districts.
